Andrea's devotion to the Krewe is second to none and they really kept the Honor Guard and even the Top Six, informed and developed a strong bond with them.


It has been a pleasure to have them as my right hand!


The Queen's dress was handmade with love by her mother, Delores Shear, of Crestview. It is an elegant sheath made of Navy Crepe Back Satin that compliments the Captain's Navy and Silver Brocade Pirate's coat and vest. The dress was exquisitely adorned by costume designer, Tim Ellzey of Mobile, Alabama with navy and black lace, then layered overall with gunmetal and clear Swarovski crystals to add just the right amount of sparkle for the occasion. The queen's jacket with ¾ length sleeves was created from the same dress fabric by Mr. Ellzey to complement the dress and add a royal collar fit for a queen!



As a breast cancer survivor and advocate for women's health, the queen's 15 foot train, also designed by Mr. Ellzey, is fashioned in the subtle shape of a breast cancer ribbon using the Navy and Silver Brocade worn by the Captain, a cancer survivor himself. A beaded cross adorns the top of the train and "Celebrate Life" is scrolled along the bottom of the train to represent the queen's deep appreciation for life after cancer. The entire train is framed with imitation black fur to add a royal touch.

Her beautiful crown was customized by Dynasty Collection of Mobile, Alabama. It features pear-shaped and round AB Swarovski crystals that complement the same jewels surrounding her medallion. Let's not forget the customized shoe embellishments upon Navy Patton pumps, which completes the outfit. She has also been known to kick the dust up with a pair of navy sparkle cowboy boots every now and then for the right occasion!

BOWLEGS HISTORY

illiam Augustus Bowles, a notorious old boy and patron pirate of the Billy Bowlegs Festival and the Krewe of Bowlegs, was born in 1763 on the Maryland frontier. He was raised a loyalist to the British Crown, and accepted an

ensign commission as a British Naval Officer at the age of 16. After the war he rebelled against military life, insulted a British officer and went into hiding with the Creek Indians (so the legend goes). He adopted the Creek culture and language and married a chief's daughter. In 1781 he returned to Pensacola with a war party to aid the British in defending their garrison against the Spanish. Though the British lost, Bowles survived, and his initiative gained him a British pardon. During that time the British, Spanish, and Americans were maneuvering for control of the Gulf Shores

and its shipping lanes.

Believing himself destined to command instead of obey orders, Bowlegs gathered a force of a "couple of hundred plundering Indians, relics from the American Army, and white banditti". This rollicking, piratical crew grew to be the concern of all three of the powerful countries. Captain Billy created his own throne and the three nations considered everything from murder to a general's commission to get him on their side. Financed by loot from a Spanish ship and surrounded by a handful of Indians, Captain Billy invaded the British Society for support. He was rewarded with a flag of "English and Indian colors mixed", a silver pipe, a tomahawk, a chain of friendship, and trade supplies which he used to form the State of Muskogee. He was eventually captured by the Spanish and shipped to Madrid, Spain. While being shipped to the Philippines, he jumped ship and returned to his "state" and great deeds of piracy. Eventually he was betrayed and captured by a rival Creek faction in the swamps surrounding Choctawhatchee Bay, where tales and legends abound to this day of Billy Bowlegs' buried treasure. The Spanish imprisoned him in Cuba in the infamous Morro Castle where he died in 1805, at the

Гwo centuries later, the memory of William Augustus Bowles lives on in the annual Billy Bowlegs celebration. To the Emerald Coast, Captain Billy left a heritage of pirate tales, great adventure and buried treasure!

The Billy Bowlegs Festival started in 1953 as a water ski show sponsored by the Jaycees. It quickly grew to a weeklong festival and the 1957 Bowlegs Festival souvenir program lists the original Krewe membership as 75 men. Today, many Bowlegs members are second, and some are third, generation pirates. They carry on the tradition set forth by their pirate fathers.

As indicated by the Constitution & Bylaws, Krewe membership is limited to 170, plus the former Captains and honorary members. The Society of Bowlegs, affectionately known as the SOBs, limits membership to those who have served the Krewe as Captain Billy.

A new Captain Billy is selected each year from the Krewe membership by secret ballot. The past seven captains are solely responsible for the secret nominations. Once the new Billy is selected, he chooses his Queen, First Mate & Mistress, ten Honor Guard couples and the Children of the Court. The late Docie Bass, Captain Billy Bowlegs IV, was the first to select his Queen from the wives of the Krewe membership. Prior to that, the Queens were "captive wenches" and beauty contest winners. Krewe member's children and grandchildren, that are high school seniors during the year, represent the Krewe as Princesses and Privateers. The identities of the entire court are kept secret until the elaborate Coronation Pageant.

Krewe members and their wives (the wenches) spend many hours designing and creating float, stage, and ball decorations each year that celebrate the colors, theme, and emblem that is selected by the Billy. Elaborate costumes are custom made for each member of the court in the selected colors. The costumes are worn throughout the year as the court represents the Krewe in the local community and as they travel as ambassadors to other cities to participate in festivals and parades. The Krewe enjoys camaraderie with other crews as far away as St. Paul, Minnesota where they participate in the Winter Carnival.

The Billy Bowlegs Pirate Festival is celebrated the first weekend in June each year. The community comes together to put on a colorful, but futile, display of bravery in defense of the city destined to be overrun by pirates. The Skirmish on Friday night is followed by a full-fledged invasion of over 300 pirates and wenches at the Landing on Saturday. The victory celebration is topped off with the Torchlight Parade on Monday evening where adults and children are showered with booty amassed during a We ARE THE KREWE OF BOWLEGS







